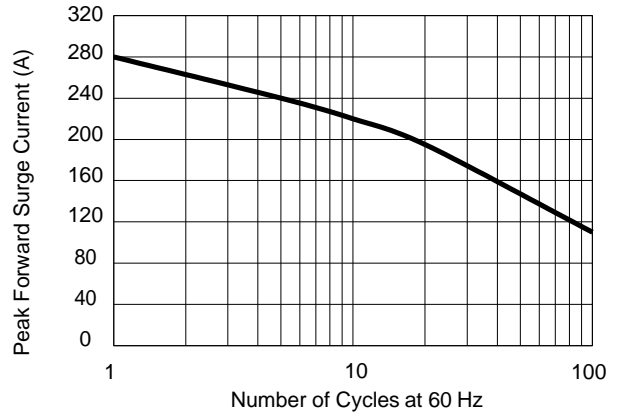

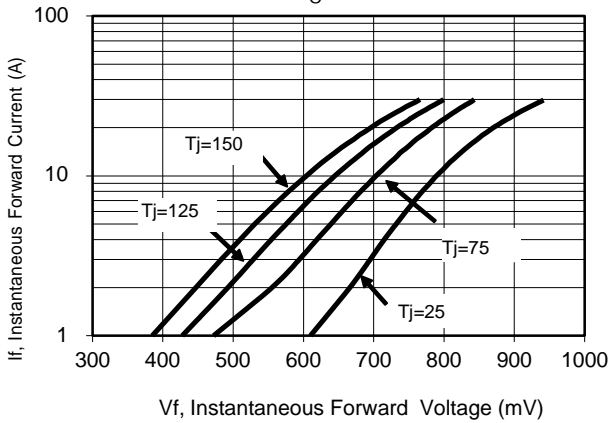
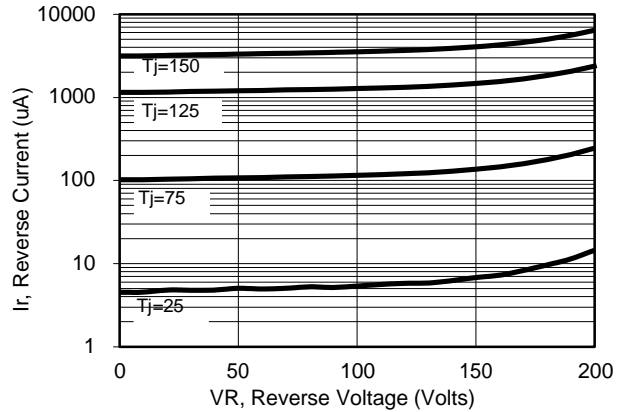
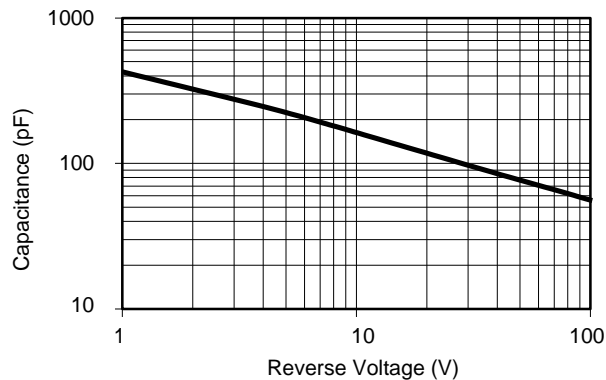


Figure 2: Maximum Repetitive Surge Current
